HIGHEST PARTICIPATION OF WOMEN IS NOTED IN THE KNOWLEDGE 64% **MANAGEMENT ASSISTANTS TEAM 53% NALAS SECRETARIAT** AND THE TASK FORCE 50% ON SUSTAINABLE TOURISM
