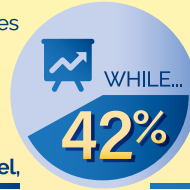

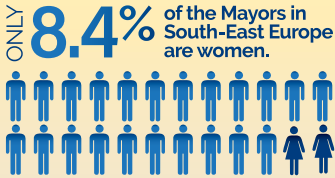

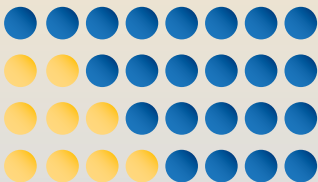

## GENDER EQUALITY IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATIONS



OF THE MEMBER LGAs DO NOT HAVE SPECIFIC POLICY DOCUMENTS REFERRING TO PROMOTION OF GENDER EQUALITY.

OF THE PRESIDENTS OF NALAS MEMBER LOCAL GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATIONS (LGAs) ARE MEN.

57% OF THE LGAs DO NOT HAVE A PERSON DESIGNATED AS GENDER FOCAL POINT.

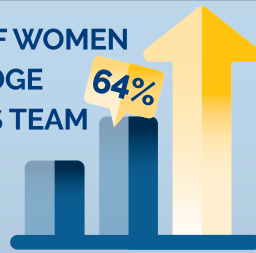


In 57% of NALAS member LGAs the administrative staff is predominantly women.



## GENDER EQUALITY IN THE NETWORK

HIGHEST PARTICIPATION OF WOMEN IS NOTED IN THE KNOWLEDGE MANAGEMENT ASSISTANTS TEAM 53% NALAS SECRETARIAT AND THE TASK FORCE ON SUSTAINABLE TOURISM 50%



THE BIGGEST DISPROPORTION IS NOTED WITHIN THE NALAS GENERAL ASSEMBLY, WHERE ONLY 13.3% OF THE DELEGATES ARE WOMEN.
