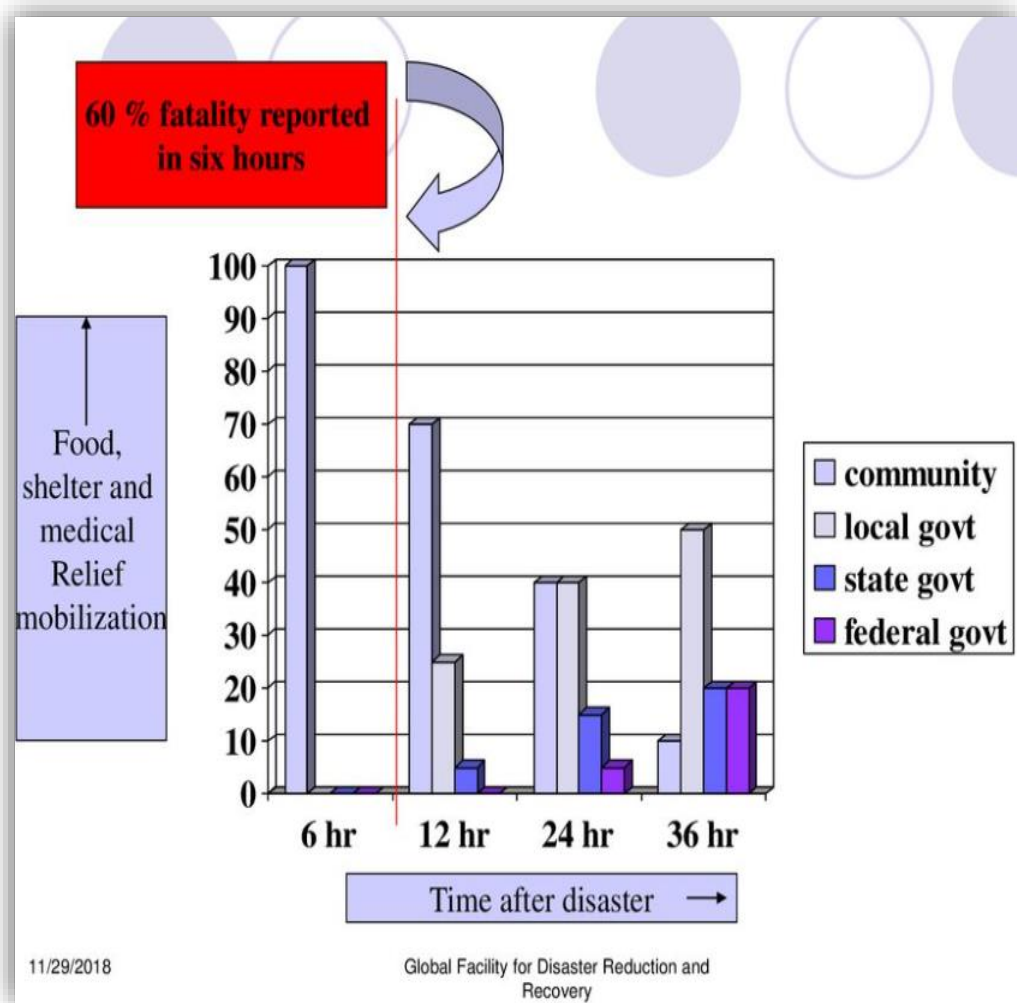
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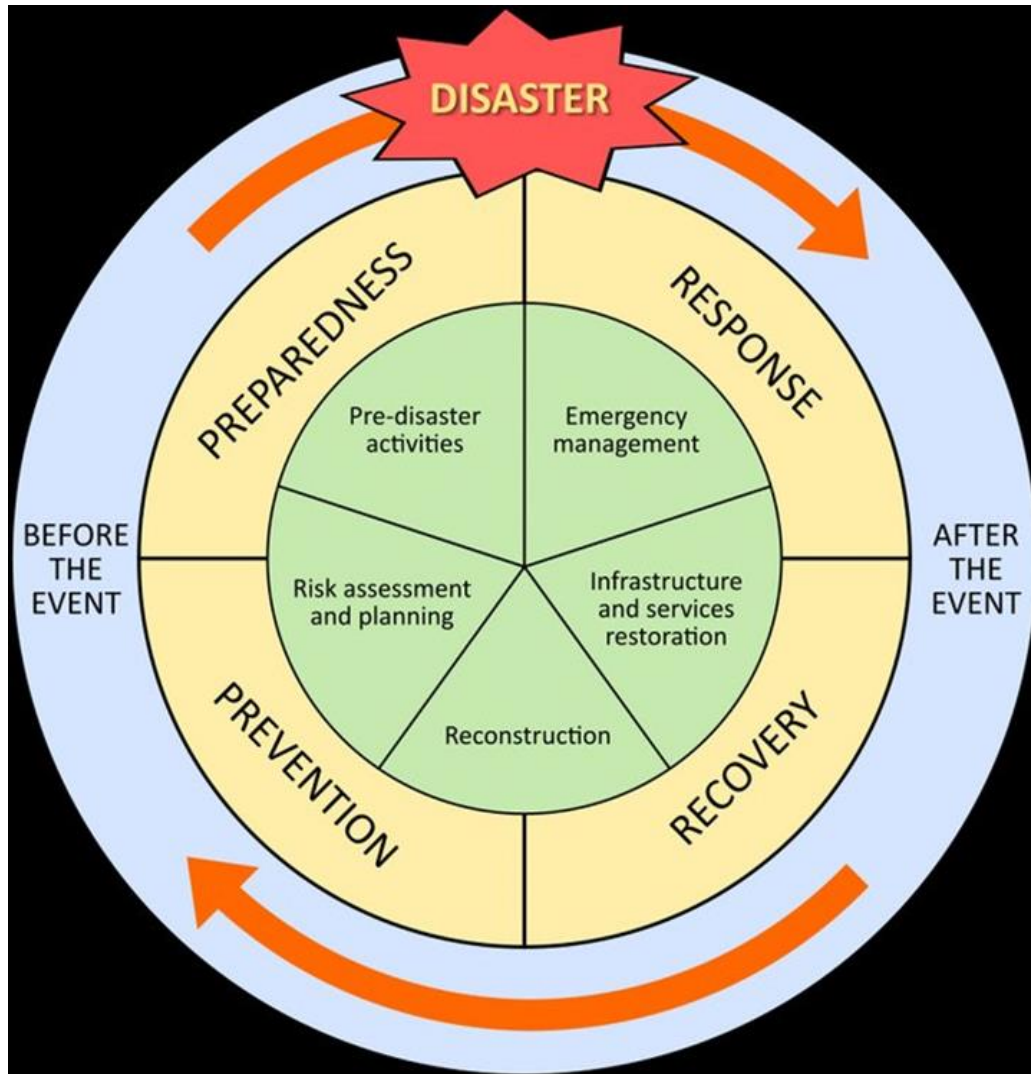

Impacts of disasters

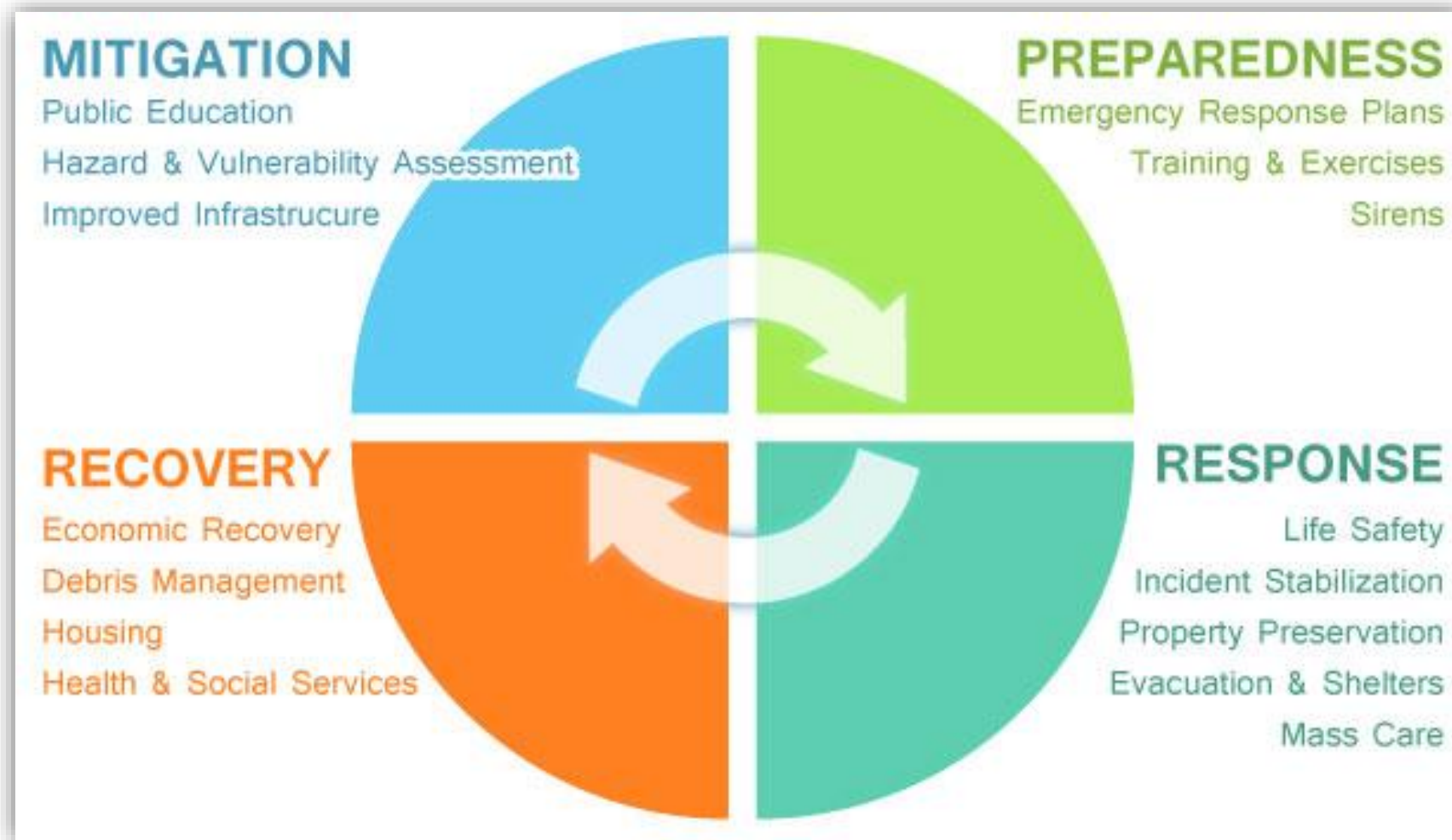


- Impacts on local level - greatest
- Communities/municipalities – first responders and delivers of assistance
- Local response immediately responsive for local needs
- Women, children, the elderly, disabled and other vulnerable groups most affected
- Their voices are least heard and recognized

Inclusive approach to Disaster Risk Management



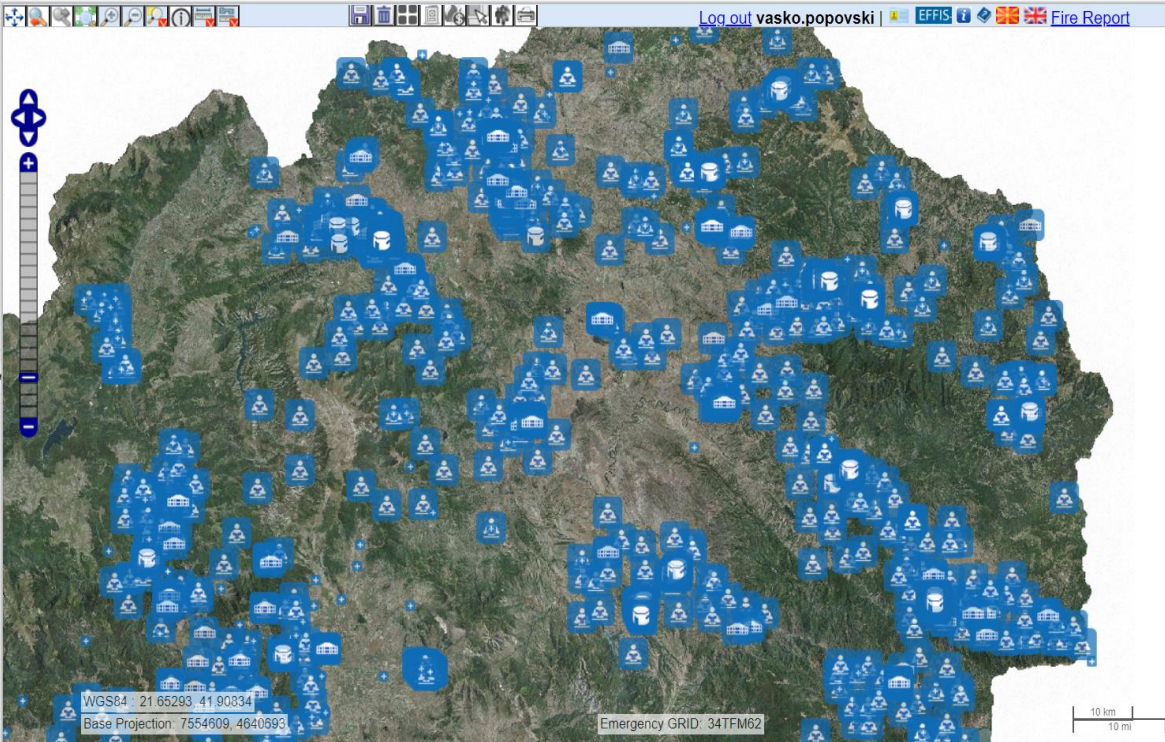
Community-based Disaster Risk Management



Local level actions

- **Prevention/mitigation:** vulnerability assessments, risk and hazard assessments, structural/non-structural measures, education, financial investments...
- **Preparedness:** EWS, Disaster preparedness plans, trainings, disaster drills
- **Response:** Public alerting systems, emergency operations, search & rescue
- **Recovery:** Immediate recovery actions, needs assessments, counselling, resilient recovery, Build-Back-Better, access to income and employment.
