





Impacts of disasters




- > Impacts on local level greatest

- Local response immediately responsive for local needs
- ➤ Women, children, the elderly, disabled and other vulnerable groups most affected
- ➤ Their voices are least heard and recognized

Community-based Disaster Risk Management



Local level actions

- ➤ **Prevention/mitigation:** vulnerability assessments, risk and hazard assessments, structural/non-structural measures, education, financial investments...
- Preparedness: EWS, Disaster preparedness plans, trainings, disaster drills
- ➤ **Response:** Public alerting systems, emergency operations, search & rescue
- ➤ **Recovery:** Immediate recovery actions, needs assessments, counselling, resilient recovery, Build-Back-Better, access to income and employment.
