# Planning implementation

**Goals:** develop information base and knowledge

**Results:** first municipal datasets; bottom up  
**Sample** of 7 Western Balkan countries, with different capacities

**Conditions of success:**

- a) data collection: *availability?*
- b) comparability: *terms and definitions?*
- c) database development: *mgmt capacity, basic IT?*

# Information by municipalities for 2008-2011

- I. **Available, detailed, computerized**
  - Albania: complete, 2002-
  - Croatia: 2001-; detailed on liabilities, guarantees
  - Montenegro: no functional classification
- II. **Detailed, but transformation is needed**
  - Kosovo: provided by FreeBalance
  - Macedonia: raw data
- III. **Partially available, not sufficiently detailed:**
  - BiH/RS: first time shared with ALVRS; not comparable
  - Serbia: Statistical Office grouping (available at MoF)
- IV. **Survey: BiH/FBiH (collected for MoF, as well!)**

# Data content

- ▶ Local legislation was followed: terms, codes
- ▶ Reclassification for comparison:
  - Own source revenues: revenue base, rate, reliefs are locally controlled
  - Capital revenues: one time (e.g. property related, sale)
  - Shared revenues: taxes, fees shared by origin
  - General grants: taxes shared by formula
- ▶ Capital expenditures: not available by sectors
- ▶ Debt stock: incomplete
- ▶ Supplementary data: population, employment salaries, classification of LGs

# From datasets to database

## 1. Regular transfer of data:

- format, timing, contact point
- procedures: free of charge, “favor”, “pressure”
- conditions : public use,

## 2. Capacity to manage information:

- technical: cleaning, indicator design, reporting
- IT: hardware, formatting, updates
- financial sustainability

## 3. Use of data and indicators:

- internal: analysis, negotiations, info to investors
- public: transparency, benchmarking

*LGAs: interests, capacities, cooperation?*

*NALAS: analysis, monitoring, negotiation with donors*
