1. Introduction

NALAS is a network of associations of local authorities of South Eastern Europe. It brings together 16 Associations which represent roughly 9000 local authorities, directly elected by more than 80 million citizens of this region. The NALAS Secretariat, based in Skopje, is responsible for the overall coordination and implementation of the activities.

Effective monitoring system and better coordination among different development and sectorial policies are basic conditions for achieving territorial cohesion and territorial development goals on transnational, national, regional and local level. Project "Assessing Territorial Attractiveness in SEE" (ATTRACT-SEE) will support policy makers to achieve better coordination of territorial cohesion and growth policies as well as their implementation and evaluation.

The Project is implementing by 19 partners from 9 countries (Austria, Hungary, Italy, Netherlands, Slovenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Macedonia and Serbia), lead by Leading Partner - Geodetic Institute of Slovenia.
