 25 27 September 2015, New York
- ➤ 17 (Sustainable Development) Goals, 169 targets und equal number of indicators
- Successors of Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) formulated in 2000

Particular features



- Universal character
- > Focus on sustainable development
- Recognition of the importance of cities and municipalities for a sustainable global development
 - -> SDG 11 (the sub-national or urban goal)
 - -> most other goals also have an urban dimension





Relevance of cities/municipalities for SDGs



- Places with particular challenges for sustainable development:
- -> more than 50 percent of the global population lives in cities (2050: almost 70 percent)
- -> more than 60 percent of the world's refugees live in cities
- -> often extreme social inequalities in urban areas
- > ... but also potentials:
- -> huge leverage
- -> 80% of global GDP in cities
- -> centres of (social) innovation

Example SDG 10



"Reduce inequality within and among countries"

Tasks of cities and municipalities:

- Provision of basic services (education, health, water etc.)
- Promotion of local economic growth and inclusive housing
- Encouragement of participation of minorities in local consultations, positions and elections

Why are the SDGs important for cities and municipalities?



- Offer orientation for sustainable and integrated development planning
- Are a point of departure for monitoring in (locally) relevant areas
- > Allow linking up to sources of development finance
- Provide a basis for inter-municipal exchange and networking

Important steps?

- Sensitization and awareness raising
- Advocacy with national strategies
- Planning for implementation
- Monitoring and evaluation



Internal und external influencing factors

- Existing local development plans
- Degree of decentralisation
- Availability of resources
- Existence and quality of data

Conclusion



- Cities and municipalities are of central importance for implementation of SDGs
- But SDGs do also have an added value for municipalities
- Necessary condition is adjustment of SDGs to local conditions -> "localisation"
- Municipal partnerships can support this localisation process
