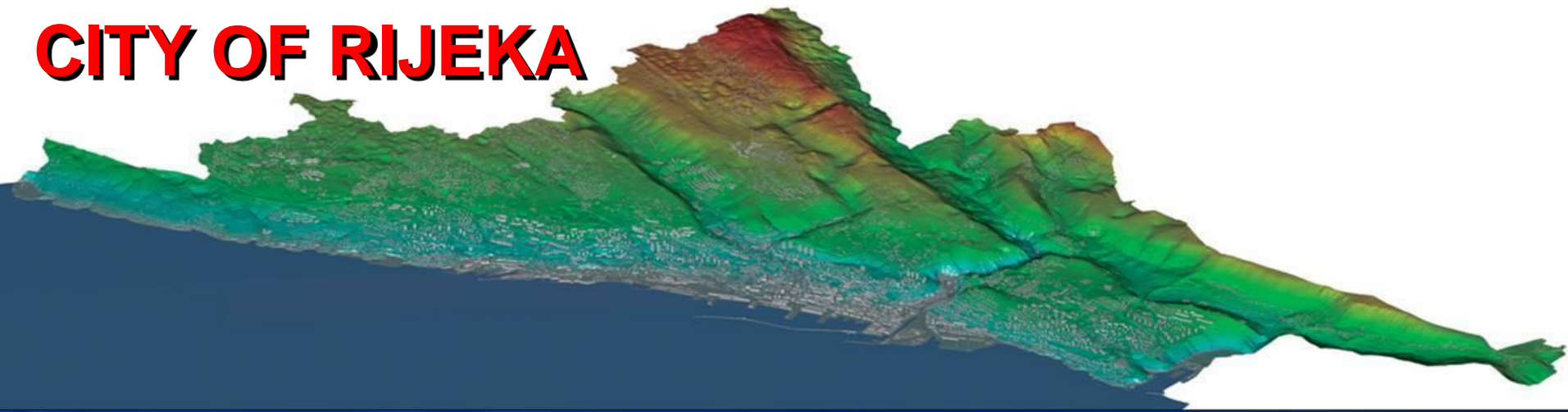

- Population: 128,735





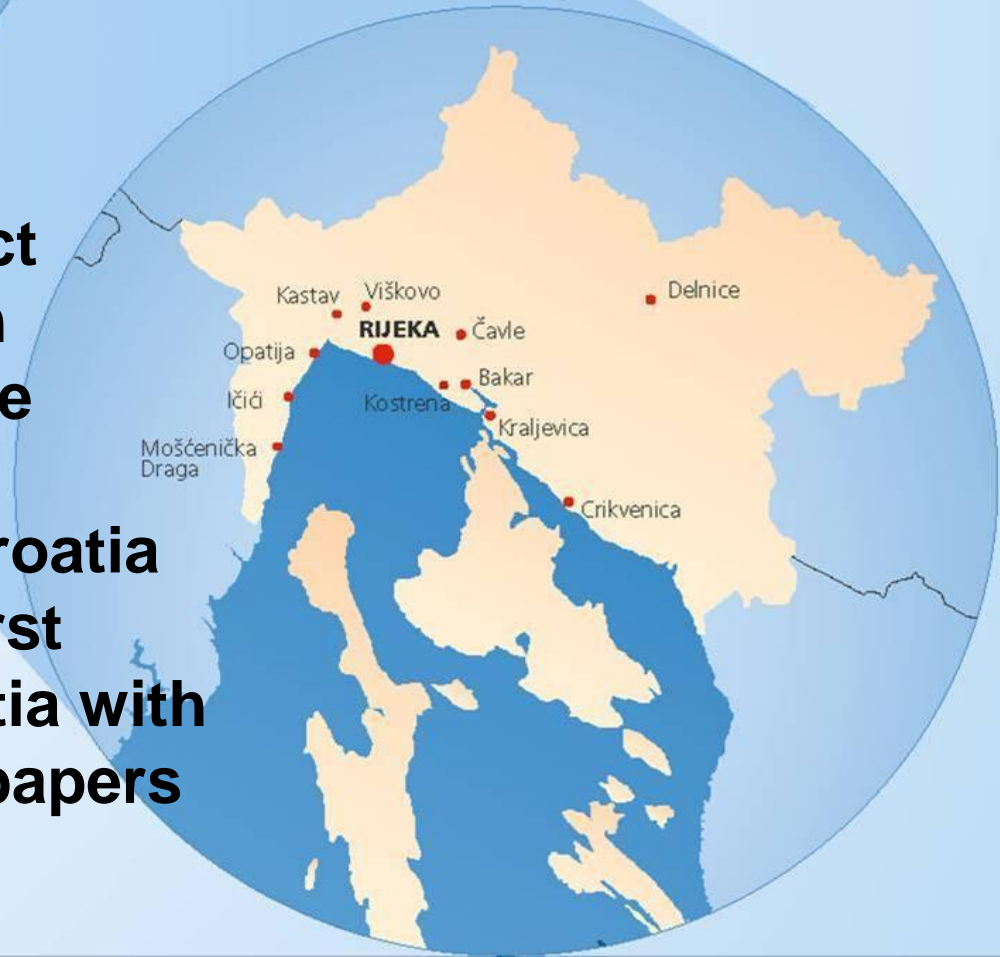




# CITY OF RIJEKA

- ***Rijeka promet*** – the first city company in Croatia with issue of commercial papers and corporate bonds



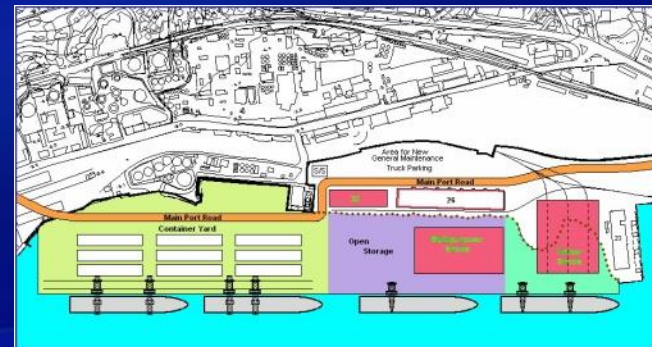
